A6 Fairfield Roundabout Project- local community support excels....

Galliford Try Infrastructure in partnership with CR Civil engineering and JCBalls Earthworks have delivered some much needed improvements to the Cunningdale allotments site. Allotments provide local communities with a place to relax, enjoy nature, and indeed socialise with likeminded people.

The site, situated to the rear of the Tongue Lane industrial estate provides both the Fairfield estate and the wider Buxton area with the opportunity to develop a small piece of land into their own Sanctuary.

Through proactive discussion and close collaboration with High Peak Borough Council, it became apparent that the allotments would benefit from a designated level parking area for those who use the allotments and to clear an area to open up as additional allotments to the south.

To support these aims the site team cleared away overgrown site vegetation and site debris and levelled the two identified areas. To provide the parking area we reused the stone that was originally imported for the site compound office. This localised re-use of construction material has provided not only costs savings, but environmental benefits by reducing the carbon footprint of delivery wagons required to remove the material away from site.
