

Wandsworth	The local Management Advisory Committee (MAC) has a partnership project with the café on Wandsworth Common. The café sells bags of waterfowl grain to raise money for the MAC whilst the MAC work to engage people feeding inappropriate food and redirecting them to buy grain from the café.	
Wandsworth	Annual egg treatment is currently used in parks across Wandsworth and has been included successfully in their management for many years.	
Sutton	Feeding discouragement: formal signage.	
Merton	Feeding discouragement: informal, humorous signage.

Croydon	Fencing at Waddon Ponds to break up open water and prevent bankside access.

Lee Valley	The LVRPA have carried out a variety of management methods; initially scarers such as scarecrows, gas guns and geese alarm calls devices were used, but the geese soon became acclimatised, making these methods less effective.	
St James's Park, London	Notices and website: 'Both Canada and Greylag Geese are common around the lake. As these are aggressive species that also do a lot of damage to vegetation we ask you not to encourage them by feeding them.'	
The Regent's Park, London	There are plans to put a fence around the boating lake to stop 400 Canada Geese flocking to the park in June to moult. *	Plan abandoned. The Royal Society for the Protection of Birds criticised Royal Parks for pushing the birds into "a smaller and smaller space".
* Canada Geese cannot fly during the six-week annual moulting process, when they shed old feathers and regrow new ones, between June until mid-July.		
East Lindsey	Large Canada Geese population in coastal towns of Mablethorpe and Skegness. * Removing eggs has no effect as the goose lays more. Oiling the eggs leaves them intact externally so the goose continues to sit but undeveloped as the embryo gets no oxygen.		
In 2014 Sandwell Council admitted it removed and killed 220 Canada geese from parks in Tipton and West Bromwich. Public outcry about practice and process with flawed consultation.		
Bordeaux	Step-over wire fences by waterside and wildflowers established on river banks.	
Serpentine Walks	Few geese visitors: running water, no lakes, wildflower planting, long grass. Ducks do cross Burlington Road: flying, swimming through the tunnel or waddling across road. A heron flies in. Muscovies used to retreat there from swans.
